2025 Synod Meeting of Synod of Victoria/Tasmania

The weekend before last, Sylvia and I attended the 2025 meeting of the Synod of Victoria/Tasmania. We met on Saturday morning with a worship service at Kingswood College in which the new Moderator, Rev Salesi Faupula was inducted.

Three major decisions were made by Synod:

- 1. Synod meetings will now be held every two years rather than every eighteen months.
- 2. To adopt the vision, goals and administrative processes for the Faithful Futures program that is designed to improve the ability of existing and new congregations to be viable.
- 3. To agree to the proposed Response to the Yoorrook Justice Commission Final Reports and Truth Telling requesting land or sale proceeds of land with little or no title consideration, to the Traditional Owners. This involves 127 of about 4,500 properties held by the Synod Property Trust. This decision is important as it expresses the Uniting Church's position in regards to the rights of, and compensation to, the peoples of the First Nation.

The 603 Toorak Road property is not one of the 127! If you would like more information, Sylvia and I welcome you talking to us.


