THE VOWS

I, [man/woman] invite you to share in my life as my partner. I declare my love for you and my commitment to you. I promise to always respect your needs and accept you as you are. I will be supportive, unselfish and trusting. I will work for a happy life for both of us.

I, [man/woman], take you [woman/man], to be my wife/husband. I promise to be true to you always, in sickness and in health, in poverty or wealth, in my thoughts and in my speaking. EXCHANGE OF RINGS

The wedding ring is a visible sign of an inner spiritual bond that links [Partner 1] and [Partner 2] together. As [Partner 1] and [Partner 2] exchange these rings they acknowledge that this is a seal of the vows they have made to each other today.
