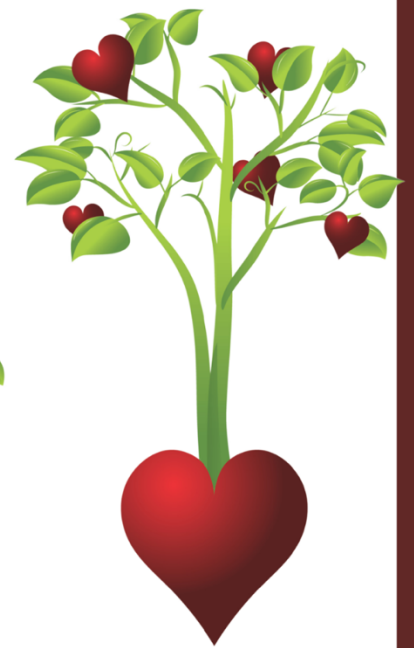
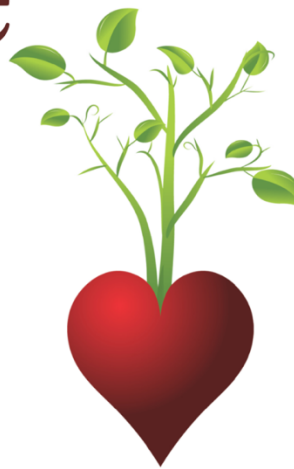

TOORAK UNITING CHURCH EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING OF THE CONGREGATION

To be held at 11:00am on Sunday 12th July 2026 (or so soon thereafter as the completion of the 10:15am service permits) in the Church

An Extraordinary General Meeting of the Congregation will be held at 11:00am on Sunday 12th July 2026 (or so soon thereafter as the completion of the 10:15am service permits) in the Church.

The agenda will be as follows.

1. To consider and if thought fit to approve the contribution by Toorak Uniting Church of \$2 million as a capital contribution to the cost of repairing the Church spire.
2. To consider and if thought fit to resolve that any drawing from the Bequests Fund that is necessary to meet the contribution of \$2 million does not constitute normal recurrent expenditure.
3. (Subject to agreement as to terms being reached between Church Council and Synod) to consider and if thought fit to approve the terms of repayment by Toorak Uniting Church to Synod of any part of the cost of repairing the Church spire that is paid by Synod due to any inability by the Congregation to pay any such part of the cost when it falls due for payment.

First Aid Course & CPR Refresher - 3:30pm on Saturday, 25 July

Life Saving First Aid is running a Provide First Aid and Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) course at TUC to give us the opportunity to acquire new skills or update our training.

Provide CPR Refresher Course, 3:30-4:15pm

Involves 1-hour online pre-learning + 45 minutes training & assessment

Designed to equip individuals with vital know-how to recognise and assist someone who is unconscious and not breathing.

Provide First Aid (includes CPR) Course, 3:30-5:30pm

Involves 3 hours online pre-learning + 2 hours training & assessment

Designed to provide crucial skills to respond swiftly and effectively during emergencies.

Cost and Bookings

Provide CPR Refresher is \$90 and Provide First Aid (includes CPR) is \$125. **TUC will cover 50% of the cost for members of the congregation who wish to attend either course.**
