

### Christian Meditation Group - Tuesdays at 7.30pm

A Christian Meditation Group is starting at Toorak Uniting Church which began in 2007 at Gardiner UCA, then transferred to Armadale UCA and now is moving to TUC. Our sessions begin at 7.30pm and go for approximately an hour and take in a short talk aimed at deepening our understanding of the way Christian meditation can work in relation to Christianity as a whole and prayer in particular. We then meditate for 25 minutes and finish with spoken prayer.
